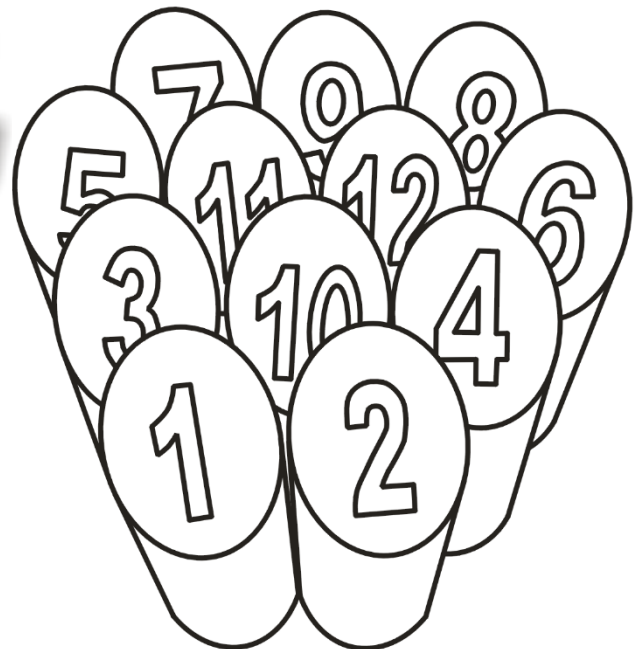

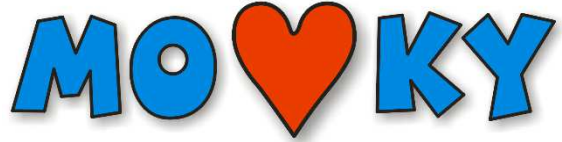

Applications must include names and surnames of players, e-mail and mobile phone number of the double's captain.

Max. number of doubles:

“A” – Tournament CSMO of mixed doubles: 20 couples

A mixed double for tournament A is:

- a couple of players (man & woman)
- a couple of players in which at least one player is under the age of 18

„B“ – Amateur doubles tournament: 12 couples

A double for tournament B is:

- a couple of players in which at least one player is under the age of 18 (e.g. father/mother and son/daughter, grandfather/grandmother and grandson/granddaughter, sibling couple, etc.)

It is possible in both tournaments to register a couple with one optional substitute player, so that all games of the couple will be played as a mixed double. Priority is given to those who have registered earlier.

The tournament is organized as part of a project **"We learn to love Mölkky - a skittles game that brings together youth, families with children and the general public"** (acronym: **Mo♥ky**) co-financed by the Magistrate of the city of Bratislava from the Subsidy Program for the development of sports and education in Bratislava, the capital of the Slovak Republic.

Entry fee: “A” - Tournament CSMO of mixed doubles: 8 € for player
“B” - Amateur doubles tournament: free of charge

Prizes: The best 3 couples in both tournaments will receive a tournament trophy, resp. cup, medals and awards (prizes). Participants under the age of 18 will receive a medal for their participation. All participants will receive a commemorative item - a badge. The winner of the accompanying Mölkky-out competition will receive an award.

Field: Surface: clay; field dimensions: 4 × 10 m; distance: 3,5 m; throwing area defined by "mölkkari".

Playing sets: Official Tactic® playing sets.

Game: The game is played according to the rules of I.M.O.
The time limit for one throw is set at 60 seconds. The time starts when the MÖlkky has been returned, i. e. either handed over to a team member or left at the MÖlkkaari. Once per game, a team may use a time-out for an additional 60 seconds. All games of the tournament are played for a maximum of 15 throws (each team). If no team finishes the set within 15 throws, the team with the higher number of points wins the set. In case of a tie, each team throws one extra throw. Whichever team rolls roll higher value (it does not matter if it exceeds 50) will score one extra point and win the set.

Alcoholic beverages and smoking are prohibited on the fields!

Game system: **“A” – Tournament CSMO of mixed doubles**

In the first phase of the CSMO of mixed doubles tournament, the couples will be assigned to four groups of five couples each. In the primary group, the couples will play each other for two sets. The group ranking will be determined by **a)** number of sets won, **b)** the point difference, **c)** mutual match, **d)** mölkk-out. The best 4 teams from each group advance to the "Play-off", the others play a "Last Chance" tournament. All "Play-off" and "Last Chance" matches are played best of 3. Semi-finals, final and the 3rd place "Play-off" match are played best of 5. Elimination matches are played for all placings. In the case of a deciding set, the couple with the better score from the first two (four) sets starts.

„B“ – Amateur doubles tournament

In the first phase of the amateur doubles tournament, the couples will be assigned to four groups of three couples each. In the primary group, the couples will play each other for two games. The group ranking will be determined by **a)** number of games won, **b)** the point difference, **c)** mutual match, **d)** mölkk-out. The best 2 teams from each group advance to the "Play-off", the remaining couple plays a "Last Chance" tournament. All "Play-off" and "Last Chance" matches are played best of 3. Elimination matches are played for all placings. In the case of a deciding set, the couple with the better score from the first two sets starts.

Referees: Teams will judge the game themselves, only in case of disputes will the couple captains contact the tournament's head referee. Only the semi-final and final matches are officiated by the referee.

Results: Results are recorded by the couple captains themselves. At the end of each game, the captains sign the completed protocol and the captain of the winning couple gives it to the person in charge. The couple captains are responsible for the correct protocol.

Protest: Can be raised within 5 minutes of the end of the game for a fee of 5 €. The fee is payable at the time of submitting the protest to the tournament organizing committee and is in the case of a negative decision non-refundable. The Organizing Committee of the CSMO 2024 tournament will decide on the outcome of the protest within 20 minutes and its decision is final and cannot be appealed.

Catering:
